

# **Option Subjects (you can choose)**

- To help you further there are clips on the school website made by each option subject that tell you what the subject is all about
- You will watch these in form and you can also watch them at home with your parents/carers
- Website >> School Life >> Year 9 Options (Pathways)
- You can also ask teachers for information about the course
- Look at the Careers Wales website too



# **Option Subjects (you can choose)**

You will spend two years (Years 10 and 11) studying the compulsory and options subjects

- Students will study three option subjects. However, you need to choose five as we can't guarantee that everyone will be able to do their first three choices
- Option 1 should be the one you want to do the most, then option 2 and 3. Option 4 and 5 will be back-ups if for some reason you aren't able to do option 1, 2 or 3.





# Level 2 Desirable Entry Requirements

- In the booklet the Heads of Department have written what ideally you need to do the subject
- They have years of experience and want you to do well in the subject. They know what it takes to succeed
- Read the requirements carefully and be honest with yourselves about whether you meet them
- To help you there is a full report coming to you and your parents/carers before Christmas









## Think...

- What am I interested in and what do I enjoy?
- What do I want to do in the future as my career?
   (but remember you might change your mind so perhaps don't specialise in similar subjects too early)
- What are my strengths are e.g. are am I good at exams and will I revise? Consider - are you better with more of a coursework based subject (BTEC)? Do you like writing or not?



## And don't think about...

- What are my friends doing? Shall I just do the same as them?
- I really like my Geography teacher I'll definitely pick that subject so I can stay with them for two years.
- I don't know what Zoology\* is about but I just pick it as I can't think of anything else.
- I love watching programs about Zoology\* on television, I'll just go with that even though I know there is loads of writing and I hate that.
- \* Zoology is not a real course!



## Final Info and Advice (for now)...

- We need you to take responsibility and read and watch the resources that have been provided for you
