## School uniform - What is acceptable and what is not!

Item	Further detail
St Julian's School Black Blazer	Available from Macey's Sports only. Must be worn at all times. Other jackets/coats cannot be worn in place of a blazer
White collared shirt	Top button must be done up at all times.
House tie	Available from Macey's Sports. Must be worn with House logo showing, not frayed or written on.
Black tailored skirt	Please see the images below. Must be knee length (i.e no more than 5cm above the knee) Polyester material. No stretchy tube skirts are permitted.
Black tailored trousers	Please see images below. Polyester material only. No jeans, combat trousers, leggings (lycra material) sporting or tight fitting trousers
OPTIONAL: Black Jumper	Plain black 'V' neck jumper or cardigan can be worn <b>WITH THE BLAZER, NOT INSTEAD OF.</b> No external labels/branding permitted.
Plain dark socks	Black socks. No white, striped or patterned. No trainer socks to be worn with trousers
Tights	Plain black or natural in colour. Socks are not to worn with tights

### Other appearance standards

Standard	Further detail
Hair	Hairstyles should be sensible and suitable for a workplace. No hairstyle should draw undue attention to the wearer and so distract others, i.e. spiked too high, hanging in the face,, untidily cut. No mohawks or clipper cut patterns allowed.
Make up	Light foundation/tinted moisturiser suitable for a workplace only. Natural make- up only.
Nails	No false or acrylic nails. These will need to be removed.
Piercings	A single pair of stud earrings may be worn. No facial piercings are permitted.

**Skirts**



Black pleated or straight, knee length school skirt. Skirt should sit no more than 5cm above the knee. Polyester material



Tube skirts are not permitted. No stretchy material. No Lycra

**Trousers**



Black tailored trousers, straight leg (both boys and girls) Polyester fabric



Jeans, combat trousers, leggings (lycra material) sporting or tight fitting trousers are not permitted
