They:

- Help us become aware of the spiritual, moral and ethical dimensions of life

At assembly the theme for the week is introduced. This theme is then developed during Tutorials.

Our weekly themes encourage and stimulate students to think about issues relating to them and the wider community in which they live. We discuss significant religious festivals and events. In line with government regulations our assemblies are broadly Christian, but they are non-denominational and should be acceptable to people of all faiths and beliefs.
