Healthy for Returning to School

For the safety of all our students and staff, please can you ensure that you adhere to the guidance from Welsh Government that states:

Under no circumstances should students attend school if they:

- feel unwell, have any of the three identified COVID-19 symptoms (a new continuous cough, a high temperature or loss of taste or smell) or they have tested positive to COVID-19 in the past 14 days
- live in a household with someone who has symptoms of COVID-19 or has tested positive to COVID-19 in the past 14 days.

Advice for Shielding and Vulnerable Students

- If your child is in receipt of a **shielding letter**, then they must **not return to school**.
- If your child is classed as **clinically vulnerable**, then parents are obliged to take responsibility for deciding whether the measures the school has put in place to reduce the risk are sufficient to protect their child considering their vulnerability at this point of time. The measures that we have put in place are listed in my previous correspondence. There is no expectation for vulnerable students to attend school.
- If your child lives in a household with someone who is vulnerable, the Welsh Government advice states that students can attend school where they can adhere to social distancing.

Recorded or Streamed Lesson

Students in Year 9 and Year 10 will receive a one hour lesson that has been recorded or will be streamed each week for the next three weeks. Your child needs to log on to their Google Classroom account between 1300-1400 to access this lesson. If you do not give permission for your child to partake in a live lesson, then please can you contact your child's Progress Leader.
