Dear Parents/Carers

Re: Return to Face-to-Face Teaching

Welsh Government has announced today that students in Year 11 and Year 13 will return to school from **Monday 15th March**. In addition, there will be flexibility for schools to bring back **Year 10 and Year 12**.

In a change to plan, Welsh Government has also confirmed that schools may now welcome back students in **Year 7, Year 8 and Year 9 before the Easter break**. This would not be a full return to school for these year groups before Easter. However, schools are permitted to offer students check-ins with teachers, with a focus on support for wellbeing, and readiness for a full return to school after Easter.

The operational guidance for schools has just been released today and we will spend the remaining time this week using this information to plan the logistics for a safe return to school for all students.

More information on our plans will follow on Monday next week.
