The testing will start on the evening of **Wednesday 24 March**. There is no requirement to test throughout the Easter Holidays. Testing will then resume on the last Sunday of the Easter Holidays (Sunday 11 April). Testing will then continue every Wednesday and Sunday. Please ensure positive LFD results are communicated to the school on the evening the test is carried out.
