Covid Update

The school is still operating contact year groups which means that if a child tests positive then environmental health will expect the whole year group to self isolate for 10 days.

Please remember that LFD tests should not be used if symptomatic. Anyone with symptoms should self-isolate and obtain a standard (Covid PCR) test.

If a student inputs a LFD test incorrectly by logging a positive case, they should be directed to undertake a PCR within 24 hours. Individuals and close contacts will be required to self-isolate until the results of the follow up PCR is undertaken.

If a PCR test is not undertaken within 24 hours, then a full 10 day isolation will need to be completed.
