This summer our Year 13 students achieved:

- 3 A\* - A = 18%
- 3 A\* - C = 79%
- 3 A\* - E = 95%
- 2 A\* - E = 100%

And they went on to...

- 68% University (34% Russell Group)
- 24% Employment and Degree Apprenticeships
- 4% College

# How different is Year 12 to Year 11?

- ★ Very! Post 16 is non compulsory education
- ★ You study far fewer subjects
- ★ You have approximately 36 / 50 lessons per fortnight
- ★ You can come and go when you have lessons (sign in app)
- ★ Uniform may change

★ UCAS (for 22/23):

- September 6th - UCAS applications open
- October 15th (5pm) - early entry for Medicine, Vet Medicine and Dentistry; deadline for Oxford and Cambridge applications
- November 11th - personal statement (school deadline)
- January 25th (6pm) - UCAS deadline for university applications
- June 8th 2023 - Replying to Offers
- August 2023 - Clearing and Confirmation
  
- July 2023 - Year 12 attend USW to start their UCAS application
