Covid-19 Update

Please note that the Welsh Government changed the rules on self-isolation during the half term; this could affect your child's attendance at school.

If anyone in your household has Covid-19 symptoms or tests positive for Covid-19, then all members of your household must now self-isolate until they have had a PCR test with a negative result.

Therefore, if a household member has symptoms or tests positive, your child must not attend school until they have had a negative PCR test result. Of course, if the PCR test is positive, then the normal 10 day period of self-isolation must be followed.
