Dear Parents/Carers,

Well done to our students for their hard work over the last term. We wish everybody a safe and enjoyable Easter break. We return to school on **Monday 25th April**.

### **COVID Updates**

After Easter some of our measures will move in line with the guidance from Welsh Government; however, we will be keeping some measures in place, please see below:

The following measures will **remain**:

- **Zones** for social times;
- Entry/exit to site through **designated gates**;
- **One way system** to avoid overcrowding in corridors;
- **Social distancing** where possible, **ventilation** in classrooms and encouraging good **hand hygiene**;
- **Visitors** on site will continue to be by **appointment only**;
- **No face-to-face assemblies** until after the exams are over in late June.

The following measures will be **removed**:

- **Face coverings** in communal areas will no longer be required but students and staff may continue to wear them as a personal choice;
- **Warn and Inform letters** will no longer be issued ;
- **LFD tests** will no longer be automatically issued by school; students may collect them from student reception until our stocks run out; kits can still be ordered direct from NHS online if required;
- **Test and trace logs** at school will no longer be required; any absences due to Covid-19 after the Easter holidays need to be reported like every other absence via the absence line.

## **Catering provisions**

Service in both canteens has reverted back to plate service only; therefore, all food purchased on site will need to be eaten in the canteen.
